

### ASSAP MOPS Group Telecon Minutes #4

The ASSAP MOPS group telecon, on 10 October 2006, started at 2 pm (Eastern Time). Roxaneh, chairman, started the meeting with reviewing the proposed agenda.

1. The proposed agenda was accepted with no changes. The last group meeting (“ASSAP MOPS Meeting Minutes (SC-186 WG4) 082206.doc”) minutes were accepted as is.
2. Update on status presented to the SC-186 Plenary. Roxaneh went over the Plenary discussion points as detailed in “Working Group 4 ASSAP\_09\_28\_06.ppt”
3. Review of ASSAP MOPS outline, “ASSAP-WP07-05-ASAS MOPS\_OCT06.doc”
  - a. Sections highlighted in yellow require elaboration beyond the boilerplate text. Sections in green were added by Roxaneh.
  - b. New Issue: Is Section 1.5 Operational Goals necessary? Should we remove this section?
  - c. New Issue: Outline should be reviewed by FAA representative. There may be push back on the proposed change to the numbering scheme. Instead, it was recommended that the ASSAP and CDTI sections be wrapped up in Section 2.2 (i.e. 2.2.1 ASSAP Processing and 2.2.2 CDTI Processing) and the Equipment Performance – Environmental Conditions be placed back in 2.3.
  - d. It was recommended that Section 2.2.3.2.1.5 Background / Periodic Processing be removed and those subsections be moved up one level to be contained in Section 2.2.3.2.
  - e. New Issue: Should common time prediction (Section 2.2.3.2.1.5.2) be applied to all traffic, in Surveillance Processing? Or, should this be done as needed in Application Processing?
  - f. **Action Item #60:** Larry Bachman volunteered to write the Track Split section (Section 2.2.3.2.1.5.4). It was agreed (?) this is an issue for ADS-B, not limited to the UAT link.

- g. **Action Item #61** (Dave Thomas): Are sections 3 and 4 needed in the ASSAP MOPS document? Currently this section is very long compared to the 1 paragraph that the STP group used.
  
- 4. Schedule Review  
Reviewed the MOPS schedule, “ASSAP-WP07-06\_ASSAP MOPS schedule\_10\_10\_06.pdf”
  - a. **Action Item #62**: Roxaneh to update the Plenary dates based on comments from Larry B. and Tom M. We need to include 30 days for the FRAC and one week for the ASSAP WG to resolve comments. The Plenary meets every three months, with one meeting normally in December.
