1. Introduction to a common RTCA/EUROCAE methodology

Bob Darby presented a briefing on the methodology that WG51 endorses for application development. The methods are an adaptation of what is described in RTCA DO-264 / ED78A. WG4 felt that the suggested methodology is agreeable, and very consistent with the path that WG4 has embarked on. We also all agreed that the timing is right for a joint effort between RTCA and Eurocae.

Jonathan presented the ASA MASPS outline. Bob Darby had questions on the maturity of the service level concept. Dave Spencer gave the history of how we got to service levels. We all recognized that the service level concept is work in progress, and collaborative inputs would be timely.

2. Ways of defining a common understanding analysis and classification of ASA Applications.

We agreed that this will be one area where collaboration will be important. Eurocontrol has developed material on Visual Acquisition, visual approaches, and station keeping that will be forwarded to RTCA.

3. Future meetings:

We will attempt to meet in August. Jonathan will extend the August WG4 meeting through Friday morning, specifically to address collaboration with WG51. Jonathan is querying WG4 participants as to their availability. Bob Darby is investigating the possibility for his attending.

Regardless of whether we can meet in August, we will plan to hold 2 to 3 additional teleconferences before the October meeting in Brussels.

Agenda items 4, 5, and 6 were not discussed but will be the subject of future telecon / meetings.
